- Additions to the agenda- Shelli Masek
 - Better viewing for school concerts (Mary Grandi-Koball) Colleen Werner will look into relocating our band and orchestra concerts to a facility with tiered seating so parents are able to see their children. We will form a Performance Tech Committee and look for a chairperson that will look into live feed for concerts, digital recording for viewing online later, and projecting the concert onto a large screen for better viewing.
- Cynthia Mickelson Candidate for SF School Board
 - Cynthia is an attorney and grant writer. She has been very involved in her children's schools - Robert Frost, Patrick Henry, and Lincoln, as well as many other organizations. She would like to see vertical integration of curriculum between the elementary and middle schools and middle and high schools. She would also like to see a transitional period for the Bridges program so students can transition into middle school while still receiving the behavioral support and reinforcement.
- Chair Reports Shelli Masek
 - Field Day (Nicole Osmundson) The format will be very similar to last year. The only difference will be no live animals. There will also be a Fit & Flow class from Sanford. The students will rotate through 4 different stations. It is up to the teachers to recruit parent volunteers for their class.
 - Looking forward to next year (Colleen Werner) The school events that PTO sponsors and/or helps out with are the Peace Festival in September, the Cardboard Challenge in October, the Quiz Bowl in November, the Hobby Fair in January, the Science Fair in March, and Fabulous Field Day in May. The school also has the holiday sing-a-long in December and the Arts Festival in April.
 - Peace Festival (Colleen Werner) The Peace Festival will be held on September 22nd. We need PTO volunteers to help supervise the chalk area and photo booth. We will possibly sell pop again, but next year there will be 3 food trucks

and 2 dessert trucks. We will do maze tag instead of bubbles. Phil Baker will perform at the event again and he will also do an artist in residence program with the kids the day before so they are familiar with the songs at the festival.

- Committee Chairs Needed We need a new Science Fair chairperson(s). We may also need chair people for the Wellness Council. Some have expressed interest, but we have not received confirmation yet. Ms. Werner would also like to see a Spirit Wear chairperson so we can utilize our new graphic from Jason Folkerts. Mary Grandi-Koball is willing to co-chair with someone. Jill Smith offered to team up with her. Jill Smith will contact all the current chair people to see if they are interested in continuing on in their position next year and we will send out a sign up genius link for open positions after that.

 - We have many line items that need to be moved to different categories including the \$180.25 under miscellaneous and the \$639.80 under Book Room maintenance.

 - Next year we will make sure all staff are on the same page and turn in all requests and reimbursements to Kellie so she can update the spreadsheet. She will keep track of everything and we will write out one check to reimburse the school at the end of the year instead of writing checks to each teacher.
 - We are holding off on spending money for the book room as we are going to start a new curriculum next year and we might have new needs for that.
