- c. Next staff meeting they will be having discussions on giving quality feedback and getting coaching on providing quality feedback.
- d. Will be hosting another fun run in March Students will be running/walking for their laps; prior year top fundraising classes got to turn the admins into human cheeseballs they have been able to do this finally after Covid prevented it sooner. This should be around the beginning of March.
