- Chair Reports Past Events Jill Smith

 - Skating Party (Jill Smith) There were only 4 skaters at this party due to bad weather.

 - Conference Meals (Jill Smith) One conference night was cancelled due to bad weather, the other nights we had all the food we needed.
 - Book Fair (Jennifer Stensaas) Total sales were over \$6,800 even with one day of conferences cancelled due to bad weather. Total Scholastic profits were \$4,478 to use to purchase more books for the library and classrooms.
- Chair Reports Upcoming Events Jill Smith
 - Skate City Parties (Jill Smith) We have two more skating parties left this year one on March 7th and one on April 18th.
 - Science Fair (Sonia Ohling) The Science Fair will be held on March 14th. The Science Fair will need a new committee chair next year as well as additional committee members to help. We have a \$300 budget for this event. Sonia will put in a sponsorship request to Sanford again for the amount of \$300.
 - Spirit Wear Spring Sale (Jill Smith) We will have the same design as previous sales and will put flyers in the folders for Kindergarten Round Up. Orders will be due April 5.
 - Kindergarten Round Up (Tami Burkard) Kindergarten Round Up will be held on March 28th. The school is expecting 40-50 kids. We have 5th grade student volunteers. The PTO will have a welcome flier and a spirit wear order form in the folders for this event. Tami is coordinating other pieces like the snack practice, book giveaways, and the 5th grade tour leaders. We have a \$200 budget for this event.
 - Family Movie Night (Jill Smith) Family Movie Night will be held on March 29th. We will be showing Smallfoot. We will send out a sign up genius link for volunteers. Pizza pre-orders are due by Thursday, March 21st.
 - Art Show/Ice Cream Social/BOGO Book Fair (Jill Smith) This event will be held on April 11th. We need to schedule Dakota Snow for concessions. Ideas were shared with the art teachers and they will let us know how they would like the PTO to help. We can send out a sign up genius link for volunteers to mount artwork. We have a \$200 budget for this event.
 - Project Night (Jill Smith) We will be hosting another project night on April 26th. We need to send out an email requesting project leaders.

- Fabulous Friday (Jay Kahl) The date is still TBD. Jay is still in the planning stages looking for parent volunteers to dedicate their time in sharing their professions. The goal is that every child will participate in a session, being able to experience a presentation led by a professional giving them a better understanding of different career possibilities.
